What To Bring

Whether you bring these things with you from home or share the expense with your roommates when you get to Lubbock, the following are some things you will need to bring:

Dress Code:

The following dress code is required for classes and a few other events:

Men - Nice slacks, collared shirts, occasional ties, and dress shoes. Women - Dresses / skirts / nice pants / blouses and sweaters

***No jeans or athletic shoes during school hours

Required

Passport:

You will need a passport even if you are not planning on going to a foreign field.

School Supplies:

Folders, notebook paper, pens and pencils

Kitchen Supplies:

Each apartment should have pots, pans, kitchen utensils, dishes, and silverware.***

Mop and broom***

***Wait to purchase these items. It is possible that these items will have been left from previous AIM students.

Linens:

Sheets, regular twin size

Dishcloths and towels

Bedding: Blankets, Pillow. Sleeping bag for various trips.

Bath towels and washcloths

Miscellaneous Items:

Alarm clock, one piece of luggage (suggested size: 19"x24")

Optional

Walking Shoes - comfortable! We do lots of walking!

Vehicle - if you have one, it can be out to good use. The recommended budget does not include gas expenses or insurance coverage - please allow extra for these expenses.

Vacuum Cleaner - comes in handy. There are a few for use among all AIM apartments.

Personal Items - pictures, posters, etc for decorating apartment.

Lubbock Climate

The weather in Lubbock can be volatile and can change quickly. August weather is hot and the evenings are warm.

The weather changes a but in late September... mornings and evenings are cooler. Wind begins to pick up and it rains more than usual.

By the end of October, days will be mild and nights will be quite cool. Light jackets and sweaters will be needed.

It does get cold in Lubbock during the winter. Prepare for a few days of snow and/or ice.

In March and April, days will usually be fairly warm... with a lot of wind. It rains more than usual during this time, so you may want to bring an umbrella and/or rain jacket.
